Travelling By Air

Heathrow airport is located 24 Km (15 miles) west of central London. It is linked to London Paddington by a fast train service, the Heathrow Express. Trains depart every 15 minutes from approximately 05:00 hrs until 23:40 hrs. The cost of a one-way fare is approx. £15. Alternatively, London can be reached from the airport by Tube (Piccadilly line), bus and taxi.

Gatwick is located 45 km (28 miles) south of central London and is London's second largest airport. It is linked to London Victoria by a fast train service, the Gatwick Express. Trains depart every 15 minutes between 06:00 to 20:00 and every half hour after 20:00 hrs). A single fare costs approx. £15.00 and must be purchased before boarding the train.

Stansted airport is located approximately 55-80 minutes away from central London. Please note that there is no taxi rank at Stansted. The fastest rail link with London (into Liverpool street station) is via the Stansted Express. Trains depart every 15 to 30 minutes. A cost of a single journey is approx. £15.00.

Travelling by Rail

London Paddington, Waterloo, Victoria and Euston stations are the main railway stations in London. They are all close to the city centre and University College London. Those travelling by Eurostar will arrive at the London Waterloo station. The station is on the Bakerloo line and the nearest station to UCL is Euston Square. For travelling times to London please see <http://www.eurostar.com/dynamic/index.jsp>
